Weight Infants in Urban Nicaragua: Findings from a Qualitative Study. To describe how early caregiving practices contribute to pre-term and low birth weight (PTLBW) infants' vulnerability to healthcare services. Qualitative design using purposive and theoretical sampling of key informants and focus group discussions of low-income urban communities in Managua, Nicaragua. 28 participants: one local hospital physician, three nurses, four midwives, five perinatal nurses, eight women who had given birth to an infant with a birth weight under 2500 grams, six women who had given birth to a PTLBW infant, two family members of PTLBW infants, and five men.

Participants talked about the types of interventions available to PTLBW infants and their perceptions of the adequacy of these interventions. Barriers to accessing services included: health service models and procedures that did not consider the low-income family; little understanding of the contributions of these families to optimal outcomes; and poor medical attention given to PTLBW infants. Limitations include: exclusive use of data from participants who had an infant with a birth weight under 2500 grams and whose mother attended the study hospital; and small sample size, especially of the category of mothers who had given birth to a PTLBW infant. Urban mothers in Nicaragua struggle with access to healthcare for their PTLBW infants, and lack understanding of the interventions available. These findings suggest that policy makers must understand the ways in which early caregiving practices and social environments shape access to and utilization of healthcare for PTLBW infants.
