The post has to be driven by information and must contain appropriate photos, images, etc. It cannot be about a general idea such as "modern" art. A post that is merely a philosophical discussion on selling your house for more than it's worth or something similar does not qualify. Jokes, such as funny images or videos, do not qualify. Posts about a company's current offer or advertisement will not qualify. Please include your reasoning with each point you make. This article is extremely informative and gives information about how to obtain the Farcry2English language pack for free. It does not give incorrect information nor is it unreliable in any way. All of the information it provides points to working methods that are known to be effective at downloading the language pack for free, whether they are through plug-ins or downloads that are freely available online, etc., which are known to be legitimate means of finding things online that one would otherwise pay for. Therefore it is a useful resource as information, as all of the methods are appropriate for what it provides. The statements made by the commenter hold no merit whatsoever. Specifically, they have not been validated by any fact-checked sources and have been shown to be false. The final decision on this question is being left up to Expansion wiki community management.
