Maxine Waters one of the top critics of his presidency on Friday, taunting her with the nickname "low IQ" and urging his supporters to "Be violent" if she goes too far. "She's a low IQ individual," Trump said at a rally in Michigan, adding that Waters "doesn't have the mental capacity of her constituents." The president's comments came just as he was criticizing Democrats for their opposition to his policies and political agenda. He also said Waters "begged" for money from those who have benefited from his presidency and that she called them "un-American" and "traitors." Waters, a longtime champion of black people, has been sharply critical of the president and his administration's policies. But she is also a U.S. House committee chairwoman and has faced criticism from both sides of the aisle for encouraging constituents to harass Trump administration officials. One supporter said he wants to "obliterate" Waters, but Waters has called for a new civil rights movement. The debate over Waters' conduct continues on Friday, when she is scheduled to appear on MSNBC's "Rachel Maddow
