
Pervasive SQL ODBC driver



A: What a Pervasive ODBC Client Interface is, and what it does, is explained in the Pervasive ODBC documentation. However, if you are not on a Pervasive version 11 system (which is, apparently, the one you're using), then you need to install a 32-bit ODBC driver from Pervasive, download it here, extract it, and install it. (That's the 32-bit ODBC version of the Pervasive 11 software, and that will install a 32-bit ODBC driver on Linux and macOS.)
